

Creativity


The use of the imagination or original ideas, especially in the production of an *artistic* work.


Creativity


Use of Reflective Practice

Framework

Reflect

- How do I define creativity?

Brainstorm

- How might I further practice creative thinking?
- In what ways can critical thinking support more creativity?
- In what ways could I expand my reflective practice?

Analyze

- In what ways am I already thinking creatively?
- What about critically?
- What sort of reflective practice do I already engage in?
