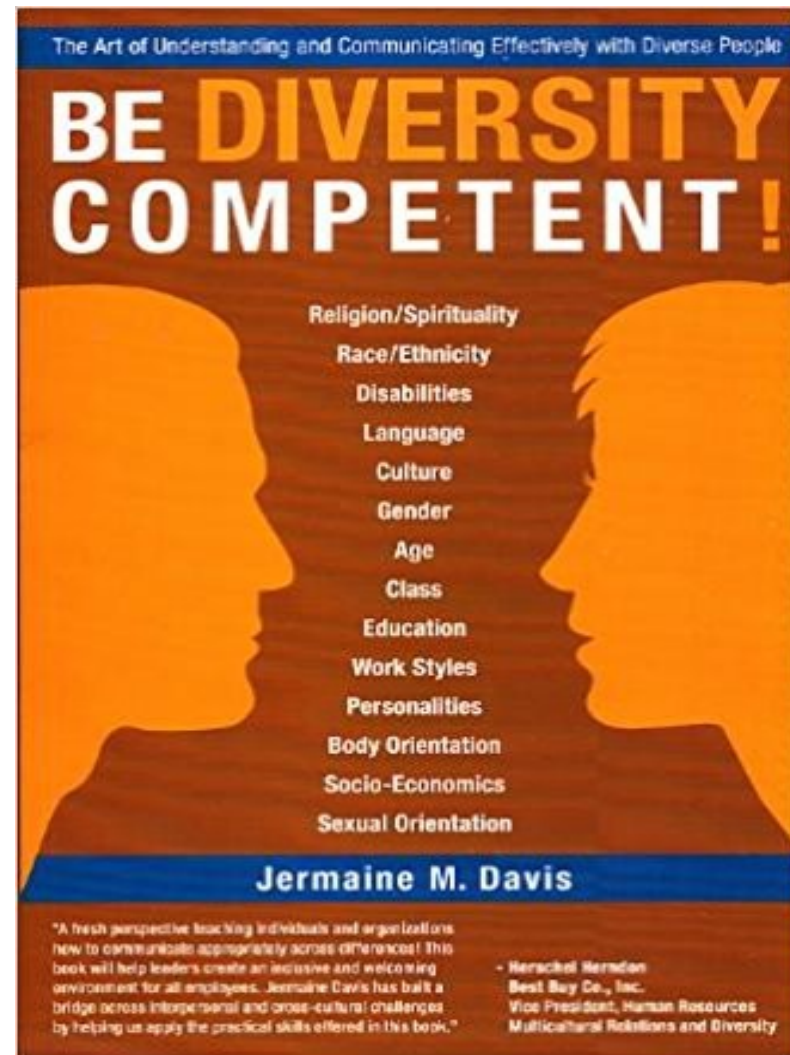
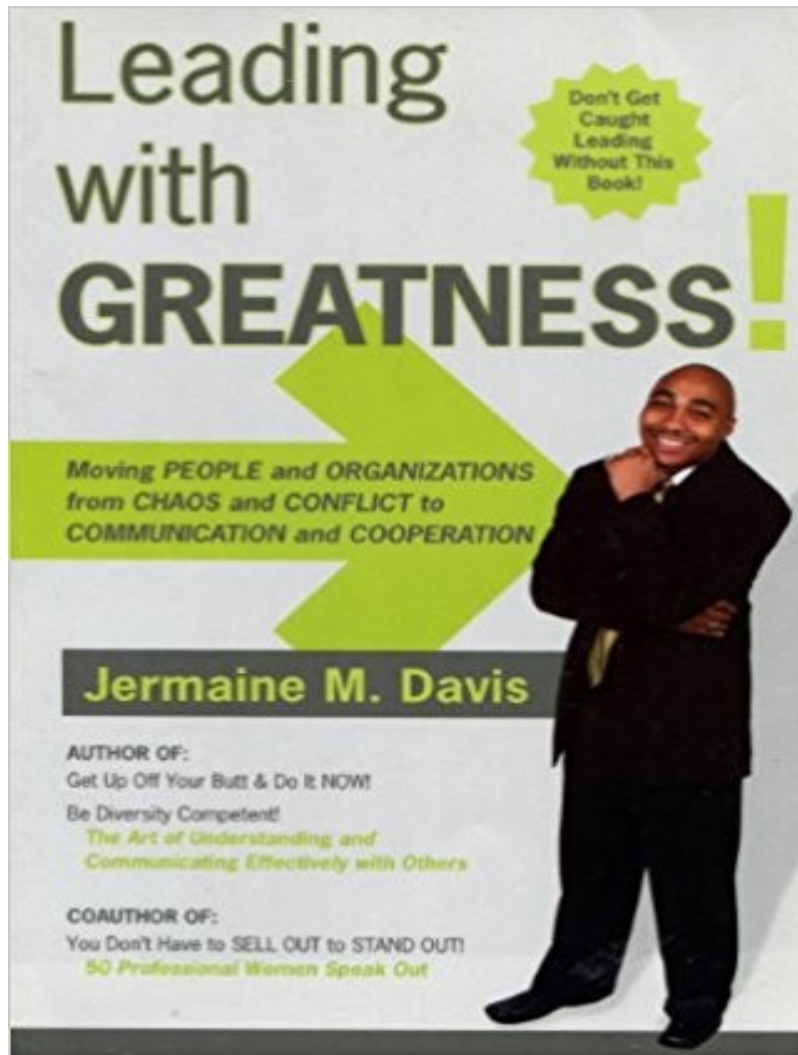

What is Leadership?

Wikipedia definition of leadership:

“Both a research area and a practical skill encompassing the ability of an individual or organization to "lead" or guide other individuals, teams, or entire organizations.”

Learning and Moving forth Creativity

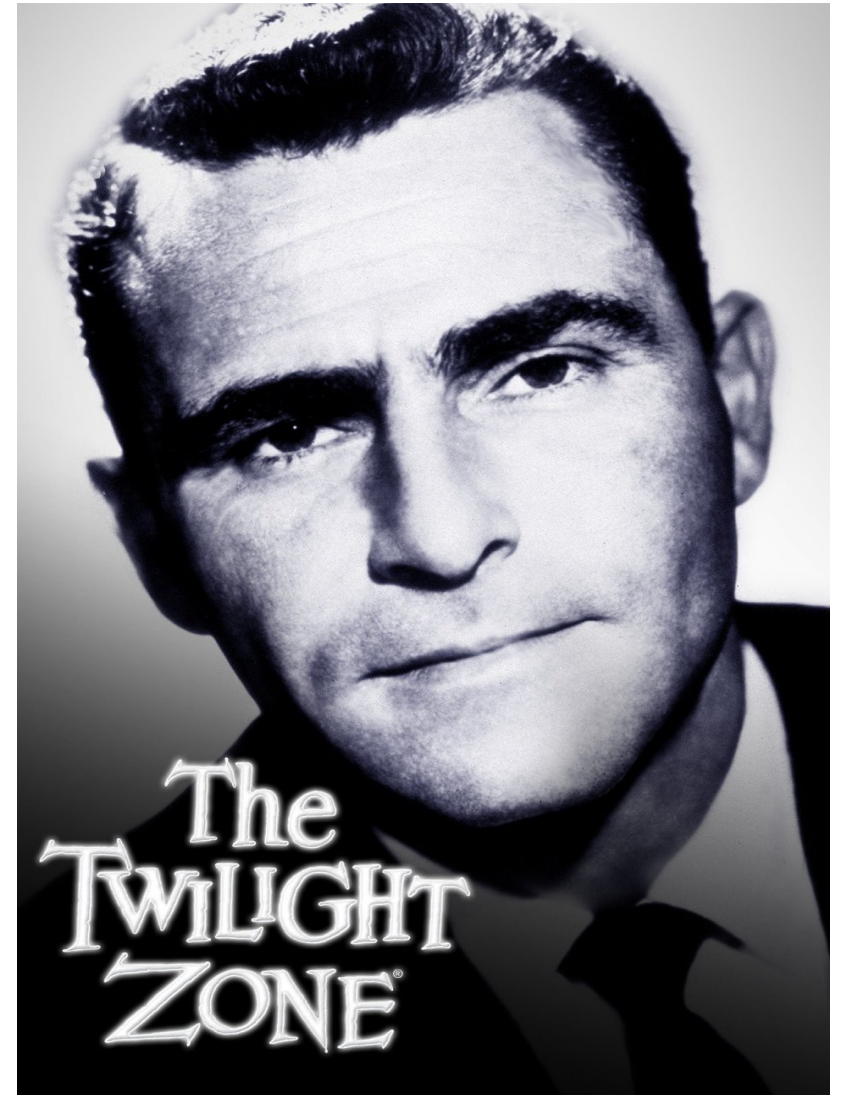
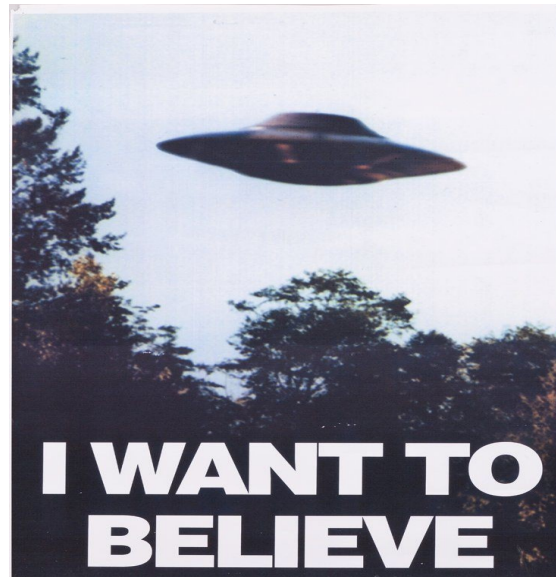
- Always keep your brain going, cerebral exercises. (chess, puzzles, painting)

- Relating class work to daily life and certain helpful interests.
- Keep hobbies such as playing guitar, dancing, and watching or playing sports games.
- Releasing negativity (taking walks, meditating, breathing exercises, partaking in things in which produce laughter or happiness)
